

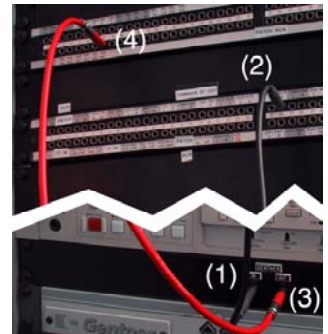
Guide to Setting up the Gentner

Please note, this is an advanced task. You should already have some experience with the mixing console before attempting this.

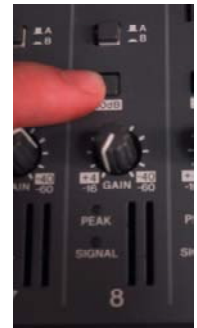
1. Make sure there is a phone splitter plugged in to the back of the phone near the audio console. It should have two phone cords coming out of it. If it is not plugged in, ask for assistance.



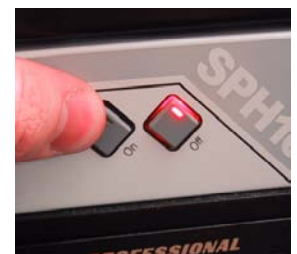
2. On the front of the audio rack, find the Gentner in/out panel. Run a patch cable from the Gentner in (1) to an auxiliary output from the mixing board (2). Connect a second patch cable from the Gentner out (3) to a microphone input (4).



3. On the mixing console, find the microphone input you ran a patch cable to in the previous step. Turn the gain all the way down and press in the -20db pad. Bring up the fader for that channel



4. On the Gentner, press the on button. You should now hear a dial tone through the stereo output of the mixing console. You can pick up the phone near the mixing console and place a call like you normally would. To end a call, press the off button on the Gentner.



5. If you want to send a microphone back over the phone, so that talent can talk with the person on the other end of the line, assign the microphone to the auxiliary channel you patched to earlier. You can do this just like you would connect the spy microphone. For example, if you ran a patch cord from Aux 5 to the Gentner in, send the microphone to Aux 5.
