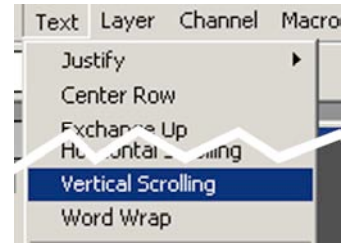


Guide to Creating Scrolling Titles on the Deko

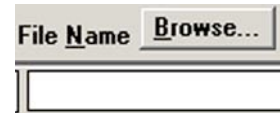
1. Select Text at the top of the screen and choose vertical scrolling. This will give you a scroll bar on the right side of the window, so that you can have more than one page of text in your scrolling title.



2. Press return repeatedly, until your cursor is a few lines below the bottom of the white box. Begin typing your credits. You can do this just as you would do any other CG. At the end of your credits, press return repeatedly again, until you have another blank page. When you are finished, save your credits. Make sure you note where you're saving the file.



3. Press the F11 key on the keyboard. This will bring you to the sequence screen. Press the Browse button in the sequence window to bring up the browser. You should see your file in the browser. Double-click on it three times.



4. To do a basic scrolling title, you want to duplicate what is shown below. An explanation of what each setting does is below, with your filename in place of "temp.dko."

1	0.	clear	temp.dko	0.		
2	pause	0.	roll	temp.dko	8.	lines/frame
3	0.	clear	temp.dko	0.		

On line 1, The Clear effect wipes the screen clean.

On line 2, The pause setting gets the roll ready. The roll effect does the actual credit roll. You can set your desired speed in the rate box.

On line 3, the clear effect cleans the screen again.

5. To begin the credit roll, double click on the 1 in the event column, and then click the play button twice. (One click gets you to the pause, the second click begins the roll). The credit roll will then appear on the character generator output. The roll itself will not show up on the computer monitor.
